If students are not wearing the required uniform, parents may be obliged to bring the appropriate articles of clothing to school. Any student in violation of the school uniform policy will be issued a warning and / or serve a recess detention.

	<u>Deodorant:</u> Students in Grades 6-8 are highly encouraged to wear unscented antiperspirant. It is not permissible				
	for students to wear perfume.				
	Hair: Students must have regular haircuts. No designs or layer haircuts will be allowed. Also students must have				
	natural hair color. No bleaching or "off" colors are allowed.				
	Jewelry: Only small earrings are allowed. Boys may wear watches but are otherwise not allowed to wear jewelry.
